

Clip Chart Discipline

This discipline system is new to me, but as I read about it I really believe this could work with consistency. Each child starts the day with their clothespin clipped in the MIDDLE of the chart that is labeled-Ready to Learn. During the course of the day, the clothespins move up and down the chart based upon the behavioral choices each student makes. Good behavior causes the clothespin to move up one level. And the opposite, inappropriate behavior, will cause the clothespin to move down one level. I believe a student using the Clip Chart, experiences a true sense of accomplishment as his clothespin moves up the chart because of his good choices. Your child will be given special rewards with multiple "clip-ups". There are goals, including retiring their old blinged out clothespin (decorated with jewels) to the "Clip Hall of Fame". Clipping down will be quite frequent, especially at the beginning and clipping up will be more difficult. The classroom rules are attached, these are the rules I feel comfortable with right now, they may expand as necessity arises. Your child will have a monthly Clip Chart in their Binders so make sure you check each day or at least each week.
